INFORMATION

All authors are welcome to submit an abstract and then a full paper for possible inclusion into the proceedings of the **International Conference on Renewable Energy – 2006, Washington, DC April 5-7, 2006**.

An accepted abstract does not mean you are automatically accepted into the program. It is the responsibility of the author to adhere to all deadlines. The deadlines as set forth cannot be extended and allowances will not be made for deadlines that are not met.

At least one author per accepted paper (or abstract) **MUST** register for the Conference no later than **March 6, 2006** in order for the paper to be presented at the Conference. If at least one author for the accepted paper has not registered by **March 6, 2006** the paper will be deleted from the Final Program (and CD-ROM if applicable) and will NOT be eligible for presentation at the Conference.

All papers must be submitted by email to wmahmoud@udc.edu Status notifications will be sent via email only. If you did not receive email notification by the posted deadline, you could check by telephone at (202) 274-5239

Review your paper for errors prior to submission. Once you have submitted your paper, you cannot resubmit it again. Only the Main author on the paper can submit the paper. The main author is also the only one that can submit changes to the paper.

FORMATTING INSTRUCTIONS **CONFERENCE PROCEEDINGS**

Please follow the instructions below:

1. FILE SIZE

The size limit of all papers is 10 **mega-bytes**.

2. REGISTRATION

In order for your paper to be published in the Conference Proceedings, one author per paper must register and attend the conference.

Registration will open in early June 2005 , and all authors will have until **March 6, 2006** to complete their registration. Registration and all pertinent registration information are available on the Conference web site at www.icredc.udc.edu

3. TITLE PAGE (top part of first page only)

1. Title of Paper

The title must be centered with at least a one and one-half inch margin on the left and right.

'Times New Roman' typeface is required, bold faced, 14 point.

2. Author and Affiliation

The author name(s) must be centered 2 spaces below the title with at least a one and one-half inch margin on the left and the right. If there are multiple authors, they must be divided by commas (,).

The affiliation(s) must be 1 space below the author name with the same one and one half inch margin on each side. If there are multiple affiliations due to multiple authors, they must be separated by slashes (/).

'Times New Roman' typeface is required, bold faced, 12 point.

3. Footer

The following footer should be used on every page of your paper. This footer is 10 points and in italics:

"Proceedings of the International Conference on Renewable Energy for Developing Countries-2006"

4. BODY OF THE PAPER (beginning under the title information on the first page and continuing with all subsequent pages)

1. First Page-The body of the paper must begin 4 spaces below the affiliation(s) on the first page (following all title information, on the same page).

The paper will be in a one-column format with left justification.

There must be a 1 inch margin on the left, right, and bottom.

Times New Roman typeface is required, 12 point, skipping one line between paragraphs.

2. Second and All Subsequent Pages-There must be a 1 inch margin all around (top, bottom, right, left) in one column format, left justification, skipping one line between paragraphs.

Times New Roman typeface is required, 12 point, using only standard symbols and abbreviations in text and illustrations.

3. Abstracts-Abstracts are not required, but can be imbedded at the beginning of the paper, not on a separate page.

4. Headings-Headings are not required but can be included. If used, headings must be left justified, lowercase, with the same font and size as the body of the paper. There must be only one space between the heading and the paragraph.

5. Page Numbering-Do not number the pages.

6. Length- There is no set limit for the number of pages a paper can or must be.

5. BIBLIOGRAPHIC INFORMATION (following body of paper)

The bibliography must begin 4 spaces below the body of the paper using the same margins as the body.

'Times New Roman' typeface is required, 10 point.

The referencing requirement is to list and number each reference-when referring to them in the

text, type the corresponding reference number in superscript form.

6. BIOGRAPHICAL INFORMATION (following the bibliographic information)

The biography must begin 4 spaces below the bibliography using the same margins as the body.

'Times New Roman' typeface is required, 10 point.

Consider each author as a separate paragraph, skipping one line between each author.

Author's name must be in capital letters, followed by up to 4 lines of text per author.
